Background

Forms of Speeches

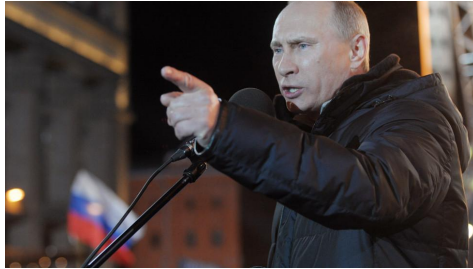
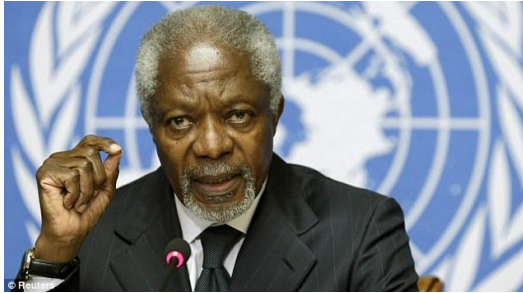
- Pre-Written = speech is written word for word, reads like an essay
- Impromptu = speaker may prepare a few bullets, but mostly formulated in the moment
- **Most speeches in MUN = Impromptu**

Contents of a Speech

- Hook = attention grabber
 - statistic, anecdote, or quote
- Point = your country's policy
- Call to Action = your country's solutions

Style

- Sight: what your speech looks like
 - eyes, feet, hands



- Sound: what your speech sounds like
 - volume, speed, tone
